

How to Borrow Tools for Your Garden

Denver Urban Gardens (DUG) partners with ToolBank USA to support our gardeners' access to tools for their garden throughout the growing season!

Steps to Borrowing Tools

1. Visit ToolBank.org
2. Click "Borrow Tools" and then "First Time Borrowers"
3. Go to HUB locations and choose #6 Denver
4. Fill out the online membership application
 - Please list your garden as "DUG + [Garden Name]", and fill out everything mandatory
 - Your executive contact will be Marisa Louri, gardens@dug.org, (303) 292-9900



Once Approved:

1. You will receive an email for a member login and to reset your password
2. Go to "members agency login"
3. In inventory, you'll only be able to see what is available at that moment. If you need a tool and can't find it, email jaime.valle@toolbank.org be notified when it will be available to check back in
4. Pick up your tools from ToolBank ([11701 E 33rd Avenue](#)) – in Google Maps it's the Salvation Army Emergency Services Center

Additional Information

- Tools can be borrowed for up to 16 months
- All tools, **even if broken**, must be returned; if tools are not returned, your garden will be charged to replace the tool
- Store tools safely. If a tool is stolen, you will need to provide ToolBank with a police report and may need to pay for the replacement
